Assignment title	25 minute timed rehearsal with a group of session players

The purpose of this assignment is to: expose students to a variety of music and situations that exercise and extend each performer's techniques and reveal where further practice is needed. To understand the value of preparation & sight-reading to aid music performance. To understand how to prepare a lead-sheet. Be able to deliver professional performances in a wide range of situations, to develop an adaptive, professional approach to continual improvement of your musical and vocal skills. Physically being able to play or sing with fluency, dexterity and the authority of a seasoned performer, and arriving at that point through a logical and structured practice routine.

Scenario: You will each be given a 25-minute timeslot in the live room. You will each manage and rehearse a group of session musicians a track of choice. You will perform the finished track including a solo regardless of readiness. The process will be filmed for marking and further evaluation.

- 1. You will be required to select **ONE** track (cover version or original)
- 2. You will be required to prepare **NOTATION** for rehearsal with a group of session musicians (keys, drums, guitar, bass) in a 25 minute time slot (1 sheet per musician)
- 3. You will be required to manage and rehearse a group of session musicians (keys, drums, guitar, bass) in a 25 minute time slot
- 4. You will be required to submit the NOTATION used during this assignment
- 5. You will perform (vocal, instrument, rap/mc) with the group at the end of your 25-minute timeslot regardless of readiness. **Your performance should include a brief a solo.**
- 6. You will each complete an evaluation sheet at the end of your session
